### **Native American Fishing Rights Digitized in Seattle**

In 1974, Federal Judge George Boldt pronounced the ruling (U.S. v. Washington) to reaffirm the rights of Native American tribes in western Washington to fish and manage fisheries on their accustomed grounds. A similar case from 1969, U.S. v. Oregon, had provided for the enforcement of rights for those tribes living in the state of Oregon.
